Teacher Information

- ✓ Be on time every day and come in prepared to work. On time means you are in the classroom BEFORE the bell rings. You get two "free" tardies. The third and fourth tardy will result in a 30 minute detention after school. The fifth and sixth will result in a full day in ALC. Further problems will be dealt with by administration.
